Overview

Hertfordshire history goes back to 1941 when Hertfordshire County Council entered in to partnership with the de Havilland Aircraft Company to train 15 and 16-year-old aircraft apprentices. Then, in 1952, Hatfield Technical College was built by Hertfordshire County Council. They achieved university status in 1992 and are now focused on becoming internationally renowned as the UK's leading business-facing university.

The single-campus University consists of two main sites, Havilland site and College Lane. The third, smaller site St. Albans city centre is located 8km away.

As Hertfordshire sees continuous growth it needed to implement a fully automated process where they can track and analyse real time information.
